I. M.Phil. /Ph.D. Programmes

The Dravidian University was established by Government of Andhra Pradesh under the Dravidian University Act (No.17 of 1997) at Kuppam, Andhra Pradesh. The University offers research programmes leading to the award of M.Phil. (full-time/part-time) and Ph.D. (full-time/part-time) degrees in the disciplines as detailed below:

Philosophy, Comparative Dravidian Literature, English, Kannada, Telugu, Tamil, Tulu, Linguistics, Folklore, History, Education, Physical Education, Chemistry, Biotechnology, Computer Science, Library and Information Science, Management, and Environmental Management.

II. Eligibility Qualifications

(i) Candidates with P.G. degree of this University or recognized as equivalent thereto shall have a minimum of 55% marks in the concerned subject of PG. However, a concession of 5% marks is allowed to SC/ST candidates.

and

(ii) M.Phil / Ph.D. Admissions shall be given without Entrance Test for those students who qualify UGC-NET / UGC-CSIR NET JRF/teacher fellowship holder / National fellowship holder twice in a year i.e., in January and in July of the calendar year. Foreign students would be admitted through ICCR.

Note: <u>Linguistics</u> - PG in Linguistics/Languages/Humanities/Social Sciences/Computer Science. <u>Folklore</u> - PG in Folklore/Language/Sociology/Anthropology/Fine Arts/Performing Arts/Literature and History.

Biotechnology- PG in Life Sciences. M.Pharmacy and M.Tech in Biotechnology, Bioinformatics etc.

Education – M.Ed.

Chemistry – PG in Chemistry.

Management – PG in Management.

<u>Environmental Management</u> – PG in Environmental Management, SD, Energy Studies, Management & Civil & Electrical Engineering.

III. Mode of Study

M.Phil / Ph.D. can be pursued by candidates possessing the minimum qualifications as specified below either on Full-Time (FT) / Part-Time (PT) basis. Admissions into M.Phil / Ph.D. programme will be made within the framework of reservation rules in force prescribed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh from time to time.

a) Full-Time (FT)

(a) Candidates for admission to M.Phil / Ph.D. programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 10-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.



(b) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) / Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the University Grants Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

b) Part-Time (PT)

Candidate satisfying the eligibility conditions noted under II (B) above can be admitted as part-time candidate as per the following order of priority. Admission into part-time category will be made on the basis of service seniority in the respective categories.

- (i) Regular Faculty working in the University or the P.G. Centres.
- (ii)(a) Faculty working in post graduate and professional colleges completed at least two years of Service. This provision is not applicable to Faculty teaching Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Humanities in professional colleges.

(or)

(b) Faculty/Librarians/Asst. Librarians working in affiliated degree / PG colleges and Faculty teaching Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Humanities in professional colleges having completed at least two years of service.

(or)

- (c) Faculty working in Polytechnic / Government or private aided junior colleges having completed at least four years of service. Seniority for candidates under each category shall be calculated with the following weightage.
 - (i) Teaching at P.G. level / Professional-five points for each completed year of service in colleges as specified in (ii)(a).
 - (ii)Teaching at graduate level/Professional two points for each completed year of service in colleges as specified in (ii)(b).
 - (iii)Teaching at Polytechnic / junior college one point for every completed year of service as specified in (ii)(c).
- (iii) Technical employees working in research institutes having completed at least five years of service.

IV. Procedure for Registration for M.Phil., (full-time/part-time) Ph.D., (full-time/part-time)

- i. Candidates seeking admission to M.Phil., (full-time/ part-time) and Ph.D., (full-time/ part-time) shall apply on separate application forms along with all required documents for attending interview for admission.
- ii. Duly attested copies of relevant certificates should accompany each application. Duly attested passport size photograph of the candidate must be affixed to the application form.
- iii. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected.
- iv. All queries should be made with the Dean, Academic Affairs, Dravidian University, Kuppam in respect of non-receipt of the Acknowledgement, Call letter for Interview etc.

V. Procedure for Admission to M.Phil. / Ph.D (full-time/part-time) Programmes.

1. Admission to M.Phil. and Ph.D. Programmes is based on the vacancies available. The vacancies may vary at the time of admission. The guide and topic of research shall be decided by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) concerned.



2 Interview

Applicants will be called for an interview by the University Department concerned for purpose of their selection to the M.Phil.,/Ph.D., programme where the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through a presentation before a duly constituted Committee.

Interview Committee shall consist of three members: Head of the Department, Chairperson, Board of Studies and one Senior Faculty Member from the Department nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

The interview shall be based on PG syllabus and be focused on the chosen area of work and on the following aspects:

- Candidate's competence for the proposed research;
- Possibility of organizing the proposed research in the University.
- Potentiality of proposed research for contribution to new/additional knowledge.

VI. Allocation of Selected Candidates to Research Supervisor

- **1.** The registration of a selected candidate can be done in the university department where there is a vacancy.
- 2. The allocation of selected candidates shall be made to the Research Supervisor as decided by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) concerned depending on the number of selected candidates per Research Supervisor, the available specialization among the Supervisors and research interests of the scholars as indicated by them at the time of interview / viva voce.
- 3. The Number of Research Scholars to be allowed to each teacher is as follows:

Not more than two Ph.D. scholars should be registered with a supervisor per year. A Research Supervisor, who is a Professor, at any given point of time cannot guide more than three (3) M.Phil., and Eight (8) Ph.D. scholars (both Full-time and Part-time). An Associate Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of two (2) M.Phil and six (6) Ph.D. scholars (both Full-time and Part-time) and an Assistant Professor can guide up to a maximum of one (1) M.Phil and four (4) Ph.D. scholars (both Full-time and Part-time).

XI. Payment and Refund of Fee

- 1. Registration fee once paid will not be refunded or readjusted to any other programme. Full Tuition Fee will be refunded if any student cancels his/her admission before the last date specified for the payment of fees.
- 2. If any student cancels his/her admissions after the last date specified for payment of fees, 25% of Tuition Fee of that year will be collected even if the student discontinues in the first year or second year, irrespective of whether the student has attended the Department or not.
- 3. If any student cancels his/her admission after the last date specified for payment of fees, only 75% of Tuition Fee of that year will be refunded, even if the student discontinues in the first year or second year, irrespective of whether the student has attended the Department or not.

XII. Refund of Caution Deposit

Caution Deposit has to be claimed within three years after the completion of the programme. Otherwise the amount paid will not be refunded.

The students may approach the Dean, Academic Affairs and submit the requisition letter for refund of tuition fees and caution deposit.
