Young Linguist Award for Dravidian University Teacher



P. Sreekumar, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Dravidian & Computational Linguistics, Dravidian University was conferred with **Prof. Susheela P. Upadhyaya National Award** for young linguist for the year 2017. Prof. Susheela P. Upadhyaya (1937-2014) was an eminent Dravidian linguist who has contributed substantially for the Tulu and Kannada languages. The award is given by Dravidian Linguist Association, to a young linguist below the age of 40 based on the three years contribution in any branches of modern linguistics. P. Sreekumar, who received this award, is consistently working in the field of Comparative Dravidian Linguistics, Language Typology and History of Linguistics. He is a recipient of Kerala Sahithya Academy award for the year 2010. This award is a credit for Dravidian University which is promoting standard research in linguistics. The award will be given to Sri. P. Sreekumar at the 45th All India Conference of the Dravidian Linguists to be held at Delhi University from 23rd to 25th June 2017 at the Department of Linguistics, University of Delhi.
