Minutes of the BoS Meeting of Department of English and Communications, held on 17-12-2016, conducted in the Language Lab of the Department at 12 noon on 17-12-'16.

The Chairperson of the BoS, Prof. Ch.A.Rajendra Prasad initiated the proceedings by presenting the issues on the agenda. As per the agenda, in the first place, the syllabi of MA English and Pre-Ph.D. have been reviewed thoroughly. Upon completion the task, the following have been resolved:

1. To accept in total the modified syllabus of [ENG I 003] Pedagogy of Literature(s) in English.
2. To substitute William Burrough's *Naked Lunch* with Scott Fitzgerald's *The Great Gatsby* in [ENGCO10] American Literature-II in III semester of MA English.
3. To ratify the inclusion of English Language Teaching [ELT] component in the syllabus of Paper-I, "Research Methodology," under part-B of Pre-Ph.D. exam, and to modify a part of the question paper with a view to rationalising the choice component.
4. To modify ENGC 011 "ELT" syllabus as follows:  
In the Unit-1, the component b. hereafter reads as, "A Chronological Review of approaches, methods and techniques."  
In the Unit-IV, the component b. hereafter reads as follows, "Communicative Language Teaching: Content-based and Task-based activities."  
In the Unit-V, the component a. hereafter reads as, "Lexical Approach."

**Note:** In addition to resolving to accept the above modifications which are proposed by the faculty who have been teaching and/or dealing with, the following are the minor modifications suggested by the External Members with regard to the nomenclature of the titles of certain papers and the format of the syllabus of all papers, and the same are resolved to be accepted:

In Semester-I of Two Year MA English

5. To modify the title of ENGC004 Literary Theory/Criticism: East and West of Semester-I as "Literary Theory."

In Semester-II of Two Year MA English

6. To modify the title of External Elective, "Soft Skills-1" as "Soft Skills."
7. To expand the title of the External Elective which reads as acronym "ESP" into the full form, "English for Specific Purposes."


In Semester-III of Two Year MA English

8. To modify the title of ENGC011 "ELT Basics" as "English Language Teaching"
9. To modify the title of "Soft Skills (Advanced) as " Advanced Soft Skills."
10. To modify the title of ENGI 002 "Women Poets" as "Women Writings."
11. To modify the title of ENGI 004 "Course in Academic Writing" as "Academic Writing."

In Semester-IV of Two Year MA English

12. To modify the title of ENGC014 "Contemporary Literary Theory and Criticism" as "Contemporary Theory."
13. To modify the title of ENGC 015 "Subaltern Literatures (Dalit and Aboriginal) as "Subaltern Literatures."
14. To strengthen the syllabus of ELT component of Pre-Ph.D. Exam by adding advanced trends and issues.
15. To modify the format/structure of the syllabus of all the papers in future while ~~retaining~~ writing the existing "Course Description" component by way of adding the following components:
  - a. Objectives of the course
  - b. Outcome of the course
  - c. References/Reading Books at least five in no. uniformly
  - d. Online references including web sites (if any)
16. To finalize the official list of the journals of English subject after considering the names of the journals to be sent by the External Members shortly.
